If you are staying for longer than 6 months, you will need to pay a health surcharge which will cover you for any NHS healthcare you receive*.

*Applies to Non-EEA nationals applying for a visa to enter or remain in the UK for more than 6 months. Patients in England are required to make contributions towards the cost of their NHS care so you'll still need to pay for certain types of services, e.g. prescriptions, dental treatment and eye tests.
