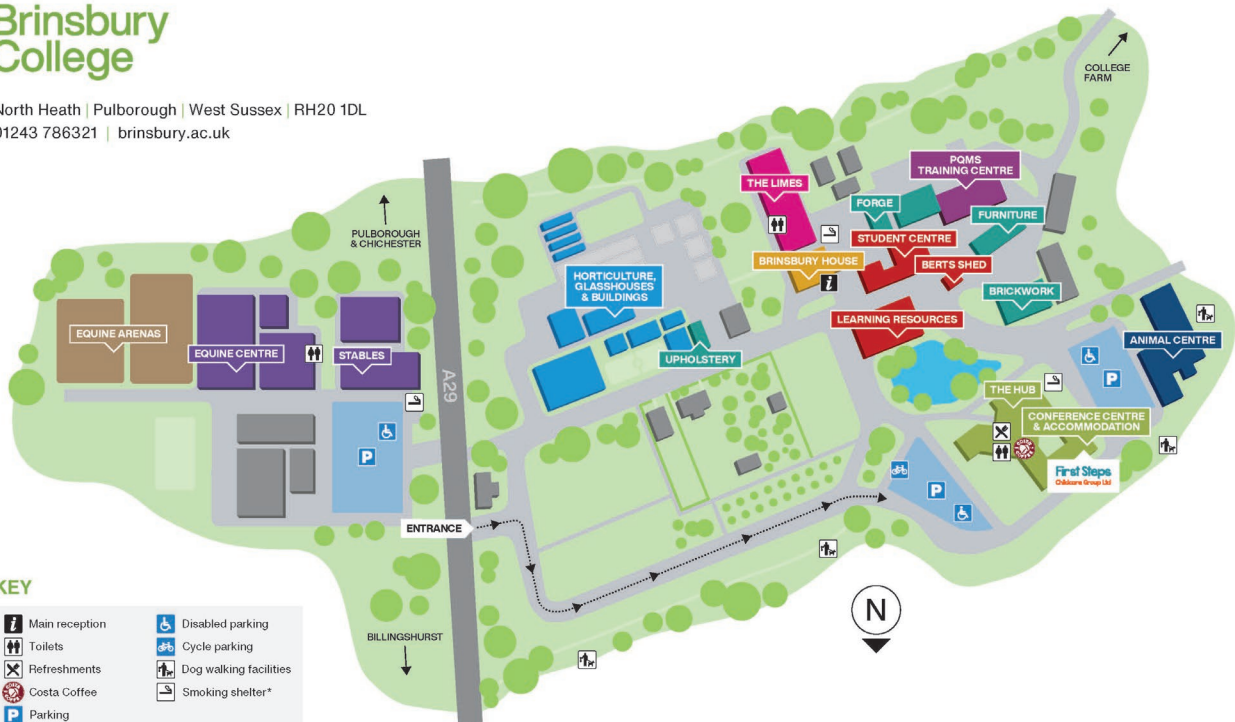


Where will I be studying?
