

BACKGROUND

In preparation for your first fashion assignment in September I would like you to investigate and document research into the following **two themes:**

- Denim
- Botanicals

We will look at each.

PREPARATION TASK 1

Research and document the theme of botanicals

Research should be a minimum of 5 pages and include:

- Primary sources (drawings/photographs).
- Secondary sources (books/internet/journals/magazines).
- Drawing Top Tips:

Drawing should include different drawing media e.g. pencils, inks and paints. You can exploit the qualities and styles of line, texture, tone and colour. Draw the whole or part of an object or picture to help you understand the shapes and forms that are contained within it.

• Present your research into an A3 sketchbook - this will be continued in (from September) for your first assignment.

PREPARATION TASK 2

Investigate the fabric Denim and its place in fashion

Investigation should include:

- Historical research what can you find out about the fabric? Origin? Construction?
- How has denim been used in fashion? (historical and contemporary) examples. Images (all sources referenced) - a mixture of photos and sketches.
- Annotation (information & labelling) eg. shapes and structures/details/colour/textures/print and surface decoration.
- Evaluation (what you like/ don't like/ what aspects inspire you).
- Further analysis drawn close-ups of particular features.
- Presented either as a power point/slide show or presented in your sketchbook
