This is compulsory and not optional. Please be aware that you cannot be awarded for one qualification without passing the other.



Summer Assignment

Access the ISTD website (<u>www.istd.org</u>) and purchase the graded syllabi (up to and including Intermediate) in the dance genres you wish to study for your DDE. These can be found by clicking on the link for SHOP and then the relevant faculty e.g. Imperial Classical Ballet, Modern Theatre or Tap.

Consider where you might undertake your teaching practice. You will be required to observe, assist, and teach ISTD classes. Discuss this with the principal of your dance school to ascertain whether this might be possible.

The dance department organise regular trips to a variety of different dance productions. Whilst these are not an essential part of your course, you are very welcome to join the other students if there is a trip you might be interested in, and it is highly recommended that you do so. Please complete the trip consent form if you think you are likely to join the other groups on trips.

Exams

You will take practical exams and submit written assignments as part of the DDE course. These are examined by ISTD examiners/moderators. Whilst one full set of exams are integral to the course fee you must be aware that if you choose to undertake practical exams in more than one genre these extra exams **must be** paid for by you. You should **budget £265.00 for a DDE Unit 4 practical exam**.
