Doctors

Upon arrival if you are here for 6 months or longer you will need to register with your host's local Doctor. To register you will need to request a Doctors letter via email: homestay@chichester.ac.uk and can then be collected from the International office, once you have this letter please ask your Host provider to help you register. If you are here for less than six months, you can still see a Doctor as a walk-in patient. If you become ill during your stay please ask your Host to contact their Doctor to make an appointment for you.

Accommodation locations and transport

All of our host providers are located within Worthing and are all within walking distance to the College. Your host provider will show you the quickest and safest route on the first weekend when you arrive. If you would prefer to use public transport to get to and from college there are local bus routes around Worthing you can use. Worthing is also located on a very good train line to help you explore the rest of the UK. Your host provider will show you where to go to catch either a bus or train.

- **Train** - If you choose to travel by train you can purchase a "Unizone" ticket for £22.30 per week (Price subject to change). This gives you 7 days unlimited travel on the train between Chichester and Shoreham. This can be purchased at the train station, you will need to show your college student card. - **Bus** - You can buy a "Worthing 7 day Megarider ticket" via the stagecoach bus app, which costs £17.00 (price subject to change) or a "Gold mega gold ticket" which costs £26.20 (Price subject to change) and gives you 7 days unlimited travel on the bus within the whole of West Sussex including Brighton. You will need to show your Student ID if using the student ticket option.
