



The Library

How do I log in?

Go to CCGOnline and log in. From the **Students** dropdown menu at the top of the page, select **Library**, **Library Resources**.

Go to Online Resources and select the icon for Ebook Central. Click on the link to Ebook Central.



Off campus, if you are not already logged into your CCG Microsoft account, sign in when prompted with your College email and password.

How do I search?


Type your search terms in the box and click **search**. This will bring back a list of books.

Use the **Advanced search** to get more precise results.

Authoritative ebooks at your fingertips.



When you have the list of books, use the options on the left of the results screen to **Refine your search**.




Click on the **title** of a book to view full details.

OR

You can use the Library catalogue to find ebooks from this resource.

Go to https://catalogue.chigroup.ac.uk



Open the **Advanced search** screen by clicking under the search box. Enter your search term then from the dropdown **Media type** choose **E-book**. This will also pick up ebooks from EBSCO and VLebooks.

How do I use the results?

You can choose from various reading or download options. Click **Read Online** to read the full text.





When you have opened a book to read online you can use the Tools menu above to download, copy, print, share, cite, highlight, or annotate the text.

Using the print or copy options automatically adds all the information you would need to reference the item.

For some books, the <u>Al Research Assistant</u> is now available which gives an overview of books and chapters.

Saving and downloading

If you haven't already done so, use the link in the top right corner of the screen to **Sign in**.

Any items **saved** will be added to your **Bookshelf** to be used in a future session.

You can **download whole books** to read offline for up to 21 days.

You will be asked to download the appropriate software to your device to do this.

Some users may not be able to use the Adobe Digital Editions app on their Android phone or tablet to download eBooks. If you get an error message when attempting to use the Adobe Digital Editions app on your Android device, we recommend using the PocketBook Reader app as an alternative.
