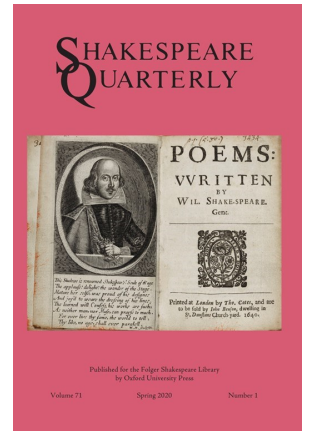

# How do I log in?

Go to CCGOnline and log in. Scroll down the page and click on the link to **Learning Resources**. Go to **Online Resources**.

Click on the link for **Oxford Journals Collection for FE**

You will automatically be taken to the journals search screen.

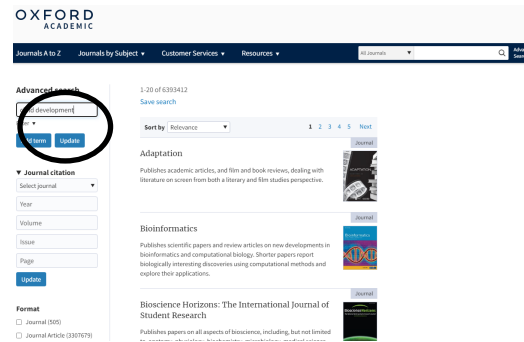
## Searching this database from home

To log in off campus, click on the person icon at the top right of the screen. This will bring up the Sign in options. Under **Institutional Access**, click on **Sign In Through Your Institution**. Type or click on **Chichester College Group**. If you are not already logged into your CCG Microsoft account, sign in when prompted with your College email address and password

## Advanced searching

Click on **Advanced search** next to the search box.

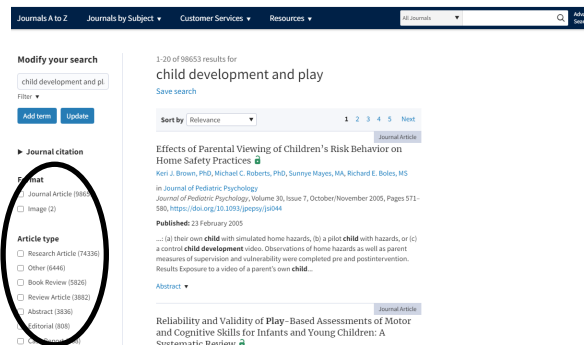
Enter your search term and then you have the choice to add another term and/or or search by full text, title, keyword using the options to the left of the screen.



## How will the results appear?

Results are displayed in relevance order (change to by date newest or oldest if preferred).

If you have too many results try limiting your search using **Modify your search** options, for example by format, subject, article type, journal name or by publication date to the left of the screen.



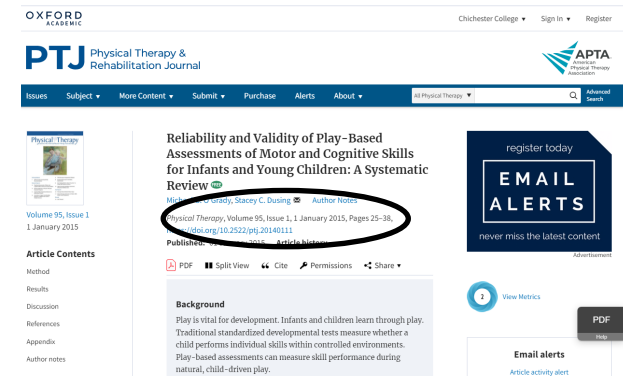
Look for articles with an open padlock or are open access or free record. Click on a title to see the full detailed record.

# How do I use the results?

On the detailed record page, click on the **pdf** icon to open the full text of the article to read, save or print.

Click on the **cite** icon to see a reference for the article.

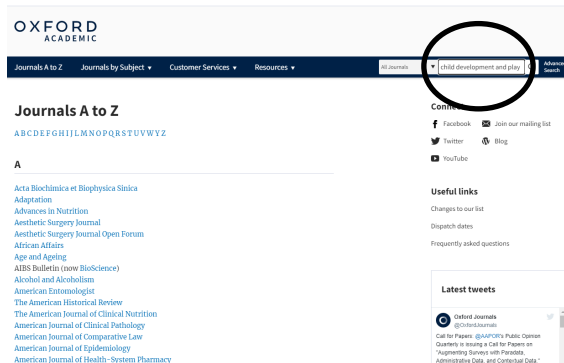
Click on the **share** icon to email or share the article via social media.
