

You will automatically be taken to the journals search screen.


#### Searching this database from home

#### How do I search?

#### Basic search


Enter your search term in the box and click search



#### Advanced searching

Click on Advanced search next to the search box.


Enter your search term and then you have the choice to add another term and/or or search by full text, title, keyword using the options to the left of the screen.



#### How will the results appear?

Results are displayed in relevance order (change to by date newest or oldest if preferred).

If you have too many results try limiting your search using Modify your search options, for example by format, subject, article type, journal name or by publication date to the left of the screen.




Look for articles with an open padlock or are open access or free record. Click on a title to see the full detailed record.

## How do I use the results?
