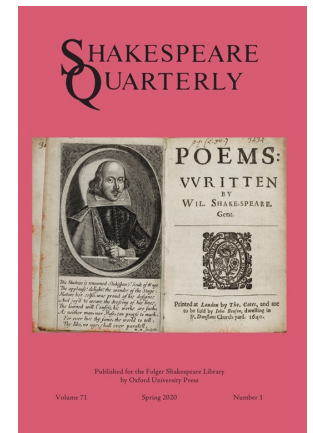

# How do I log in?

Go to CCGOnline and log in. From the **Students** dropdown menu at the top of the page, select **Library**, **Library Resources**. Go to **Online Resources**.

Click on the icon for **Oxford Journals Collection** and then the link to **Oxford Academic :Oxford Journals Collection**.

To log in or off campus, click **Sign in through your institution** on the top right. Type or click on **Chichester College Group**.



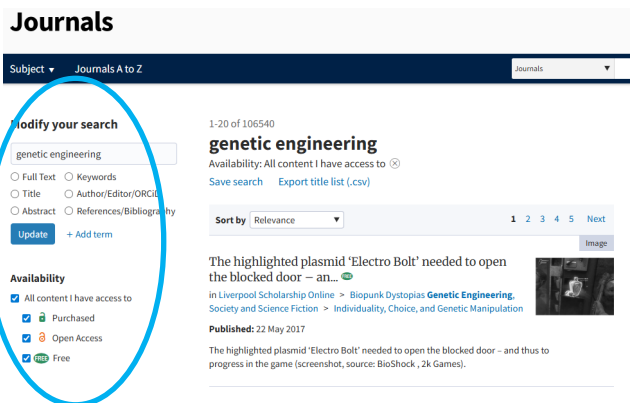

After entering your search term, you have the option to perform an advanced search by using **Modify your search** to add another term and/or search by full text, title, keyword using the options to the left of the screen. Click **Update** when you have modified your search.

Click **All content I have access to** under **Availability** to get full text articles.



**How will the results appear?**

Results are displayed in relevance order (change to by date newest or oldest, or title A-Z if preferred).

If you have too many results try limiting your search further using more **Modify your search** options, for example by **Format**, **Subject**, **Type**, **Journal** or by **Publication Date** to the left of the screen.

Click on a title to see the full detailed record.

**AI Discovery Assistant**

As an alternative to the basic search, the Oxford Academic AI Discovery Assistant can be used in your search.



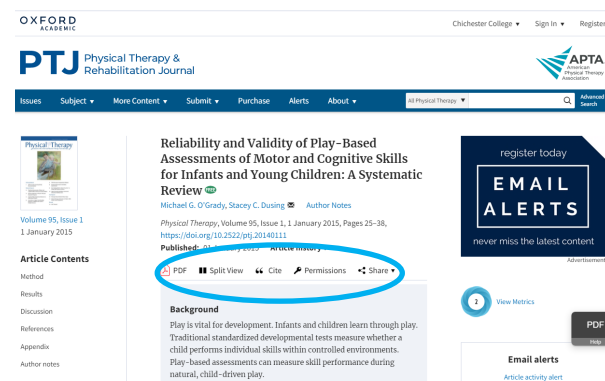
Click on the AI Discovery Assistant and type in a sentence to describe your search. The Assistant will produce 10 pieces of content with the most relevant at the top. Check the articles have open padlocks or are free for full access.

# How do I use the results?

On the detailed record page, click on the **pdf** icon to open the full text of the article to read, save or print.

Click on the **cite** icon to see a reference for the article.

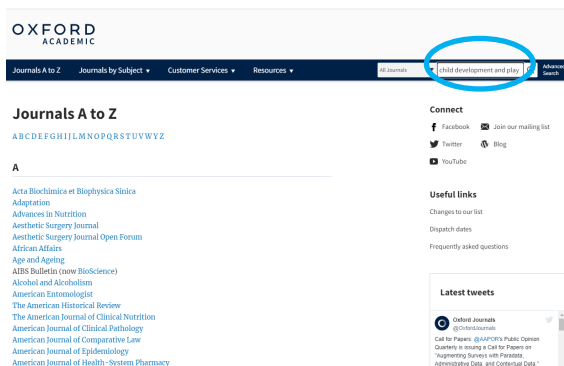
Click on the **share** icon to email or share the article via social media.
