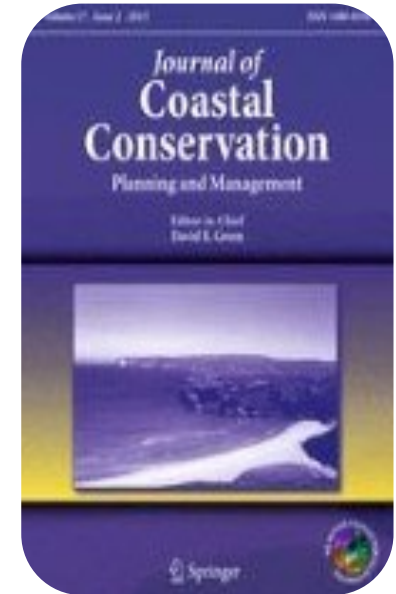

How do I log in?

Go to CCGOnline and log in. From the **Students** dropdown menu at the top of the page, select **Library, Library Resources**. Go to **Online Resources**.

To log in, either on or off campus, click on the icon for **Springer Link** and then click the image or link. Type **Chichester College Group** in the **Access through your institution** box and select it below.

You will be taken to the Homepage search screen.

Enter a search term and click return. To check which content we have access to or for advanced search, click on **go back to the old search**. The following instructions apply to the old search.

Log into your CCG Microsoft account if prompted.

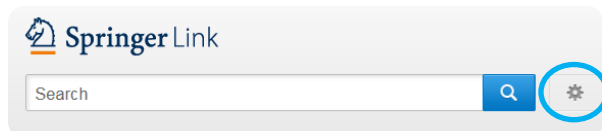
How do I search?

Basic search

Enter your search term in the box and click **search**. You can search within a search by adding more words.

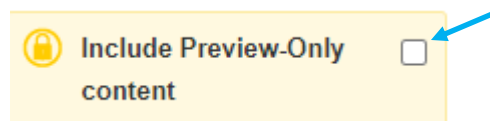
Advanced searching

Click on the **cog** symbol by the search box to open the Advanced search screen



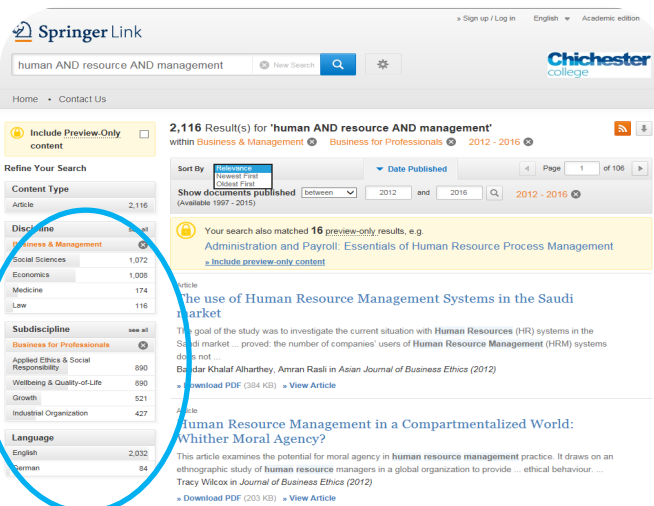
Complete the appropriate search boxes and consider limiting your search by date by selecting **Date Published** before clicking the search button.

HINT: When you have accessed the results page for your search, **untick** the **Include Preview-Only content** button. This will limit your results to the resources included in our subscription, other resources will ask for payment.



How will the results appear?

Results are displayed in relevance order (change to **Newest First** if preferred).



If you have too many results try limiting your search using **Refine your search** options, for example by Discipline/Subdiscipline or Language, on the left of the screen.

Click on a title to see the detailed article record.

How do I use the results?

You can download a PDF of the article from the results screen.

More functions are available if you click on the **title** to open the article.

Click on **Cite this article** to see **referencing information** for the article including the DOI, if available.

Under **Share this article** (following references), you can get a **shareable link** for the article. Scroll down to see the **Keywords** for the article.

Use the **Download** button on the right of the screen to open a PDF version of the full text of the article to read, save or print.

Clicking on the link for the **journal title** (under the article title) takes you to a page where you can browse all the issues of or search within that journal.
