How do I log in?

How do I search?


Basic Searching

Enter your search term in the search box and click on the magnifying glass.



Advanced Searching

Click on **Advanced Search** next to the search box. Enter your search term, choose title, author etc from the drop down menu and then click **Add field**. Use AND,OR, NOT to combine terms.




How will the results appear?

Search by Subject


Click on **Explore By** at the top, choose what topic you want to search for. You will then be directed to a page containing eBooks in your chosen discipline.



How do I use the results?

Printing, Referencing and Emailing

You can move from one page from to another using the arrows at the top centre of the pages.



If you want to enlarge the pages, there is a zoom button which is located at the top centre of the page. You can use the drop down menu to return to page fit setting.



To search for a specific term in the resource you can click on the magnifying glass to search for it.
