# How do I log in?

#### Logging in from on campus or home


Click on Log In at the top right, click on Log in via your institution. Under Find Your Organisation, type/click on Chichester College Group.

## How do I search?


#### **Basic Searching**

Enter your search term in the search box and click on the magnifying glass.




#### **Advanced Searching**


#### How will the results appear?

Results are displayed in relevance order (change to by title if preferred).




#### Search by Subject
