Since opening in 1997, we have gone from strength to strength under the Joint Venture Partners, Antony and Mackie. We are one of a group of 5 sister surgeries across the South Coast (collectively known as the Solent Group), and although we share the recognised name of Companion Care Vets / Vets4Pets, we pride ourselves on our individuality and the clinical freedom of our vets and nurses, which is recognised by our client feedback and our continued placement as one of the top three practices in the local area.

Our team currently comprise of 8 vets, 5 RVNs, 3 SVNs and 4 VCA, with 7 receptionists and 1 practice administrator. Although Antony and Mackie have been with Portsmouth for the entirety of its life, they are not the only long standing members; we have Donna, Christiane, Vera, Melanie and Nikki who have been with us between 10-20 years, and Roberto, Gideon, Amy, Dan and Hannah coming close to 10 years.

Registered Veterinary Nurse:

We encourage our team members to follow their passions, and believe RVNs should use their training. Our RVNs conduct anaesthetics, clinics, radiography, descale and polish, dental radiography, collect all blood samples, place all cannulas, all inpatient care including administering medication and are encouraged to pursue Schedule 3 procedures.

You do not need to be registered for a set number of years to add something to our team, or be confident in hands-on nursing; we offer training and we will support your development in all areas.

Ideally you would work an average of 40 hours a week, but we are a large enough team to provide flexibility for part time nurses; a typical 40 hour week includes 4 week days of 9 hour shifts, with 1 being a 1900 finish, and 1 in 4 weekends. However we are currently closed Sundays.
