If you are applying to study an **undergraduate** course, you may be eligible to receive **finance** to help you **cover the costs** associated with this.

TYPES OF STUDENT FINANCE LOANS

There are **two types** of loans that you may be eligible to receive via Student Finance England: a **tuition fee loan** and a **maintenance loan**.

TUITION FEE LOAN



Fees charged by your university/college*

MAINTENANCE LOAN



Living costs (e.g. rent, bills and food)




*excluding private providers

MAINTENANCE LOAN AMOUNTS

The amount of **maintenance loan** you can receive depends on **two factors**:

- 1** Where you will be living during your studies
- 2** Your household income (i.e. it is 'means-tested')

The **maximum maintenance loan** amounts for **2022-2023** are:

	Parent's/carer's home	£8,171
	Away from home (outside London)	£9,706
	Away from home (inside London)	£12,667
	Living and studying abroad (at least one term as part of their UK course)	£11,116

HOW AND WHEN DO I APPLY FOR STUDENT FINANCE?

Applications **open** in **February/March** and take about **thirty minutes** to complete. They can be made **online** at:

You do not need to have received and/or accepted university offers to apply.
