## Brinsbury Residential Bursary Fund Application Guidance

This guidance is to support applications for the academic year 2024-2025.

Please read this carefully before completing the application form.

## What is a Residential Bursary Fund?

- It is a Bursary available to full-time students taking land-based courses at our Brinsbury campus who live beyond a normal, daily, travel distance.
- The bursary is for accommodation costs or for travel costs if the student wishes to stay at home.
- The bursary is means tested, so the amount a student receives will depend on their family's income.

## Who can Apply?

- You can apply if your course is <u>not</u> available locally i.e., within a reasonable travelling distance:
  - A daily return journey which takes under two hours on public transport; or
  - A distance of under 15 miles from your home to the college
- You are resident in England.
- You will be studying a minimum of 15 hours per week and your course runs for longer than 10 weeks.
- You will be living in term time accommodation no further than 15 miles from the college campus.
- Your annual household income for 2024-2025 tax year is £36,000 or less.
- You do **not** receive housing benefit.
- Studying your first full time Level 2 or Level 3 qualification.
- Your course is Learner Responsive funded provision.
- Students must meet the residency criteria in ESFA funding regulations for post -16 provision.

## Financial Evidence required

- If you are 16-18 as at 31/8/24, we require parent/guardian's financial details in Section 4 of the application form and their evidence.
- If you are 19 or over as at 31/8/24 we require your financial details in section 4 of the application form and your evidence
