During the academic year, you will be able to study the full course, which consists of 3 separate awards. You will study for all three throughout the duration of the full course and these are Reading, Writing and Speaking & Listening. Each separate award requires one examination and you will only progress to the next examination, after successful completion of the one before. If you require further information on fees and funding for these, please email enrolments@chichester.ac.uk. You may be eligible for support with a travel bursary which will also gain support for things like books. You will need to apply for the bursary online <https://lsq.chichester.ac.uk> from 1st August 2024.

The first few days of the course will be for enrolment and induction. **Your timetable was issued in your interview but you may be required to come in on different days and times for the first couple of weeks to sort out enrolment. The timetables are subject to change and will be confirmed during induction.**

Please ensure that on your first day you bring the following:

1. A pen, paper & file
2. If applicable, proof of the Ukraine Family Scheme or the Ukraine Sponsorship Scheme
3. If applicable and you are 19 or over, you may be eligible for a fee waiver, please bring evidence of annual earnings of under £25,000 in the form of one monthly payslip with 3 months of your start date / evidence of benefits / section 95 letter or payment for your course.

If you drive to college and park in the college car park, please ensure to observe the notices regarding payment.
