



Terms & conditions of use/definition of service

Please read this thoroughly.

- You may only connect one single PC to the network port in your bedroom for your own personal use.
- You may not connect routers/hubs/wireless access points or similar to the network.
- The College is not responsible for any damage to your equipment as a result of connection.
- It is your responsibility to get your machine working with the network. The College does not provide support relating to the configuration of individual machines.
- Access will only be used for monitoring as below, during investigation of a complaint or to perform a remote scan to identify vulnerabilities or patch levels prior to access being granted.
- Your use of the network will be monitored to ensure compliance with College Policies and to maintain performance of the service.
- The use of file sharing agents or http tunnelling software is strictly prohibited.
- You must not access or originate material that is of an obscene, offensive or defamatory nature or which is intended to annoy, harass or intimidate another person.
- You must not intentionally interfere with the normal operation of the network or any other machine.
- Should your machine be found to be harbouring software that is a hazard to other users of the network (e.g. worm/virus) your access will be disabled
- Should you be found in contravention of any of these terms your port will be disabled immediately. You will also be subject to the Halls disciplinary procedure.
- These terms may be modified from time to time. Any modification will be advertised to all registered computer users either directly or via communal area notice boards.
- This agreement will be in place for the duration of your stay at Westgate Halls of Residence
