

Woodlands Fire Safety Form



Halls of Residence

To ensure that the importance of fire safety is understood by all occupants of the premises, we ask <u>all</u> residents to take note of the fire precautions that relate to them and their area.

Instructions to residents:

- Upon hearing the fire alarm, residents <u>must</u> evacuate the premises and assemble at the designated fire assembly point and await a role call.
- All rooms and landings will be subject to a clearance check. Any residents found inside the building during the alarm period will be asked to vacate the premises.
- Residents must remain outside the premises until instructed to return inside by staff or fire wardens/Fire Service personnel.
- Residents who fail to comply with the fire evacuation procedures will have their entitlement to residency reviewed.

Residents must:

- Make sure they are aware of all fire exit routes available to them throughout the building
- All fire doors should be kept shut when not in use, this includes bedroom doors.
- Report any fault or damage immediately to the Woodlands staff.
- Not tamper with any fire equipment, this includes fire extinguishers, fire exits, fire alarms and fire doors Please note tampering with fire equipment is a criminal offence and anyone found to be doing so will be fined
- Not smoke or vape inside the building, there are designated smoking areas around the campus
- Not use candles, joss sticks or any other item that burns or has a flame
- Not use any cooking equipment within their room
