UNDERGRADUATE 2025 - 2026

If you are applying to study an undergraduate course, you may be eligible to receive finance to help you cover the costs associated with this.

TYPES OF STUDENT FINANCE LOANS

There are two types of loans that you may be eligible to receive via Student Finance England: a tuition fee loan and a maintenance loan.

MAINTENANCE LOAN

Living costs (e.g. rent, bills and food)

*excluding private providers

MAINTENANCE LOAN AMOUNTS

The amount of maintenance loan you can receive depends on two factors:

1 Where you will be living during your studies

Your household income (i.e. it is 'means-tested')

The maximum maintenance loan amounts for 2025-2026 are:

1	Parent's/carer's home	£8,877
鸓	Away from home (outside London)	£10,544
	Away from home (inside London)	£13,762
*	Living and studying ahroad	£12 076
