- 1. Robert North
- 2. Richard Alston
- 3. Christopher Bruce.

You should create 1 page of research for EACH choreographer. The research should include the following:

- Between which years were these practitioner's artistic directors for Rambert Dance Company?
- Research into the background of the above practitioners- what was their training/experience before they joined Ballet Rambert/Rambert Dance Company?
- Find a minimum of three additional facts about each practitioner.
- What works did they create? Find images of their works
