Additionally, you'll reflect on the employability skills employers are looking for and develop a plan to enhance these skills. This project will help you kickstart your journey in Digital Services with a focus on continuous learning and personal growth.

Objectives:

- 1. Reflect on why they chose the T-Level in Digital Services.
- 2. Identify what they expect to gain from the course.
- 3. Determine what personal attributes and skills they bring to the course.
- 4. Understand and apply reflection techniques, e.g. Gibbs' Reflective Cycle.

Summer Project Instructions

We are excited to have you join us this September. To help you prepare for the year ahead, we have designed a summer project that focuses on reflection and employability skills. Please follow the instructions below to complete your project.

1. Research Gibbs' Reflective Cycle

- Task: Research Gibbs' Reflective Cycle.
- Outcome: Gain an understanding of the cycle and how it can be used for personal and professional development.
- Resources: Use online resources such as educational videos, articles, and websites.

2. Reflective Essay: Why I Chose This Course

- Task: Write a reflective essay discussing why you chose the T-Level in Digital Support Services.
- Considerations: Include your personal interests, career aspirations, and any relevant experiences that influenced your decision.
- Length: Max 500 words.

3. Expectations from the Course

- Task: Create a list or mind map of what you expect to learn and achieve during the course.
- Considerations: Think about both technical skills (e.g., hardware, problem solving, IT support) and soft skills (e.g., communication, teamwork).
- Format: You can use tools like MindMeister, draw by hand, or create a one page document.

4. Self-Assessment of Personal Attributes and Skills

- Task: Complete a self-assessment of your personal attributes and skills.
- **Considerations**: Reflect on qualities such as passion, drive, and willingness to learn. Highlight any previous experiences or activities that demonstrate these attributes.
- Format: Use a SWOT analysis (Strengths, Weaknesses, Opportunities, Threats) or write a brief reflective piece. Research SWOT analysis procedures on the internet.



5. Reflection on Employability Skills

- Task: Reflect on the employability skills outlined in attached document 'Skills and Qualities Required for New Recruits by Employers'
- Outcome: Write a reflection identifying which skills you currently possess and which ones you need to develop.
- Length: 300 words max.

6. Personal Development Plan

- Task: Create a plan outlining how you intend to develop the skills and attributes identified in the
 employability skills section.
- Considerations: Include specific actions, resources, and timelines.
- Format: Use a table, bullet points, or a detailed paragraph format. One page max.

Deliverables:

- 1. Reflective essay on choosing the T-Level course
- 2. List or mind map of expectations and goals
- 3. Self-assessment of personal attributes and skills
- 4. Reflection on employability skills
- Personal development plan
