Summer Project Brief

Welcome to the Summer Creative Media Project! This is your chance to express yourself through different types of art and media. By the end of the project, you'll have a unique collection of works that show what you care about and who you are. Let's begin!



You have 3 simple tasks:

- 1. Find a quote or lyric
- 2. Take some photos or make a film
- 3. Sketch a character

Here is some more information:

Task 1: Quote or Lyric Drawing

Pick a quote or lyric that inspires you. It can come from a song, book, or movie that you like. Using the text, draw a picture that shows what the quote/lyric means to you. You can use any art tools you want like paint, collage, or digital art.

Task 2: Photo journal or Short Film and Explanation

Every week, capture a moment from your daily life. It could be a photo or a video - whatever medium you prefer. The goal is to give us a glimpse into your world and your experiences and things that matter to you. You could include places, people, or pets, or anything that is special to you. Write a brief sentence or paragraph explaining why these are meaningful. How do these photos/films make you feel? Provide hashtags.

Task 3: Character Design and Description

Sketch/Draw a simple character with a pencil. It can be a person, animal, or something you makeup. Write a short sentence or paragraph about who they are. What do they like to do? What makes them special?

Complete these tasks before the first week of term. You'll show your work to the class. We'll keep working on these tasks together during the first project.



Don't worry too much about making it perfect - the most important thing is that you create something real and authentic. We can't wait to see what you come up with! Have fun, and be creative!
